

Deadline: All entries must be submitted to the **school office by Thursday 6th March**. Make sure your **name and class** are clearly displayed on your artwork.


Judging: Our school librarians will judge the entries, looking for creativity, originality, and how well your collage represents your chosen author!

The winning costumes will be revealed during our Friday Prize-Giving Assembly (7th March).






